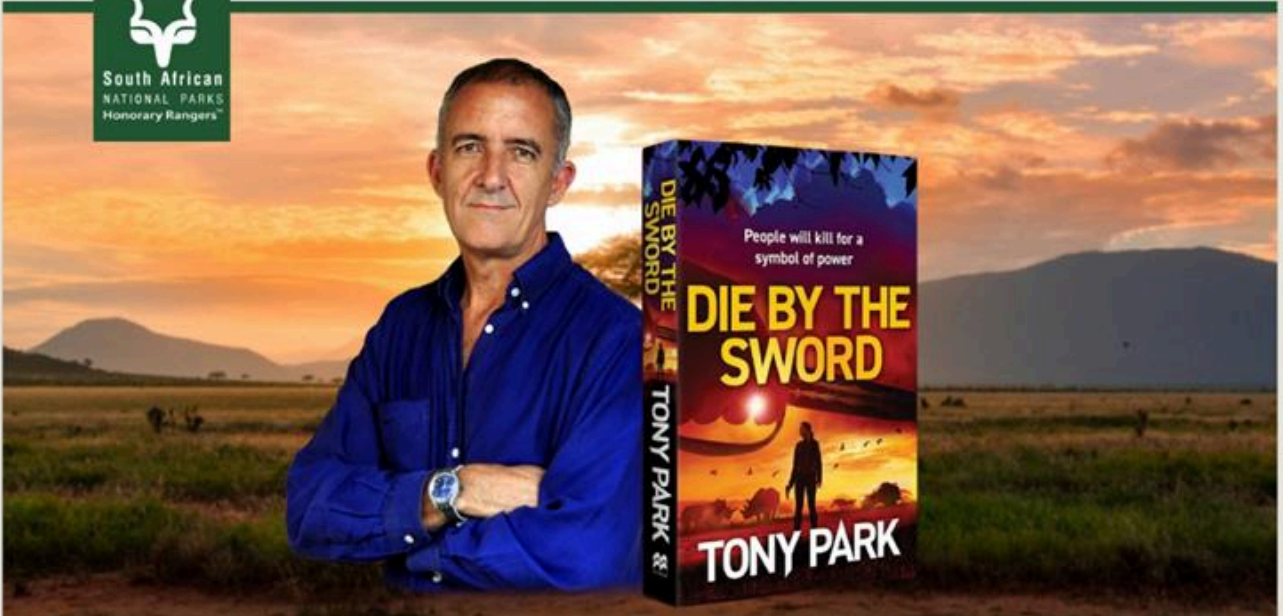
July Charity Week

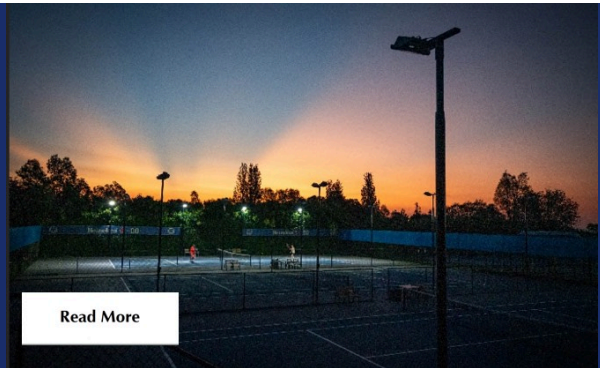

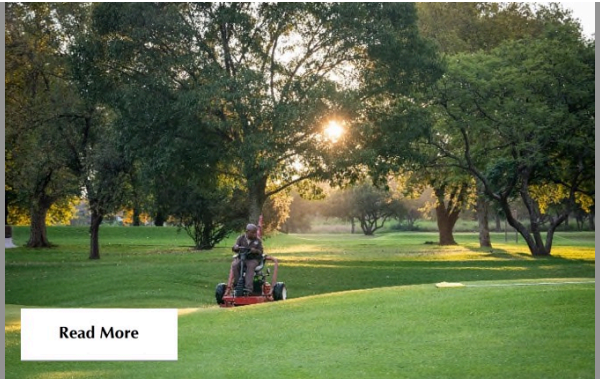
